### **Research**

Corina Konstantinou holds a B.Sc. in Biological Sciences from the University of Cyprus and a M.Sc. in Environmental Management from the University of Nottingham. Her research interests are focused on biomarkers of human exposure to endocrine-disrupting chemicals found in water-or food-containing materials. Ms. Konstantinou is participating in the European project AQUASYN, which aims the improvement of bottled water quality by the development of training sessions which will increase the knowledge and skills of the bottled water companies' staff.

The Water & Health Laboratory is part of the Cyprus International Institute for Environmental and Public Health and its main goal is the study of health risk associated with chronic exposures to environmental chemicals with particular focus on the application of novel exposure assessment methodologies. The Water and Health Lab works on: i) developing and applying novel human biomonitoring and metabolomics protocols incorporating agnostic, systematic and high throughput approaches towards a refined disease etiology, ii) conducting personal exposure assessment as well as epidemiologic studies for the assessment of the human exposome. Recent projects of the laboratory focus on delineating human exposures to chemicals, such as disinfection by-products and plasticizers that have been linked with disrupting the hormonal homeostasis during critical windows of susceptibility.
