## STRENGHTS

- Farming permitted without legally binding authorization(art.2)
- Criteria for checking, sampling and requisition, unique authority (art. 4)... No resposibility on the farmer for THC between 0,2–0,6%
- Incentives (art.6) and support for formation, dissemination and innovation (art.8)
- Food quality system (art.9)











- Food THC level
- Permitted industrial use of the biomass in all its components coming from certified seeds (DM Cannabis nov. 2015)















- Coupled prizes for industrial uses
- Small size crops
- Variety improvement
